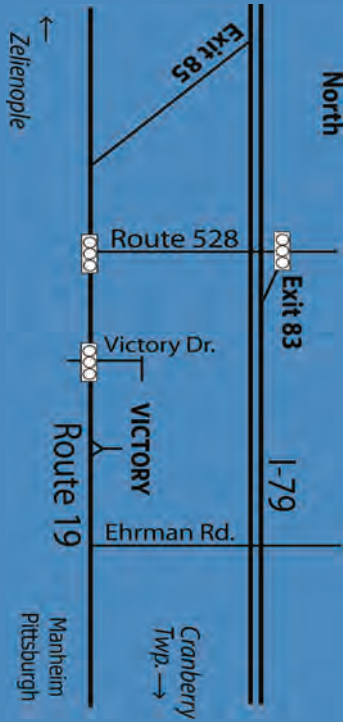


Why Victory Group?

Everyone meets together for the opening. Clean time is celebrated with key tags, cheers, applause, and hugs.

Then, the following small discussion groups meet every week:

(Steps 1-3)
- **Advanced Recovery**
(12 Steps)
- **Family and Friends of Addiction**
(FFA)
- **Restoring Women's Hearts**
(Building safe relationships)
- **Kids Like Me**
(Support for children of addiction)

After the close of the meeting, Prayer Partners are available to agree with individuals in private prayer.

About Us

Victory Group was founded as an outreach of Victory Family Church in October of 1999. Pastor John Nuzzo was presented with the idea of forming a group to minister to addicts who seek help and hope for recovery. Pastor John suggested training with Overcomers in Christ.

Victory Group started assisting people with drug and alcohol problems but has grown to include supporting people who deal with different kinds of substance and emotional addictions, as well as their family and friends. Additional groups now include separate women's discussion for those struggling with unhealthy relational issues such as co-dependency.

Our main goal is for people to feel accepted and loved regardless of where they are in life. Many times **people struggling with addiction need to know that they are loved so that**, with God's help, they can begin to make changes in their lives.

Blessing & Help

Each week we are blessed with an assortment of resources and food items which are available free of charge to all persons attending our meeting.
